Northwest Arkansas Single Parent Scholarship Fund Application Deadline Approaching

BENTONVILLE, Ark. (Sept. 22, 2022) – The Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Northwest Arkansas (SPSFNWA) invites eligible students who are single parents to apply for the spring semester degree program scholarships by Saturday, Oct. 15.

To qualify, you must be a single parent living in Benton, Carroll, Madison, or Washington counties, be a legal resident of the United States, and have completed a high school diploma or GED. Applicants can attend the University of Arkansas, Northwest Arkansas Community College, Harding University as well as a variety of others.

Students enrolled in diploma programs may pursue an associate degree, bachelor's degree, Master of Arts in Teaching, or Licensure in Cosmetology. Full-time students receive \$2,500 per semester, three-fourth-time students receive \$1,875 and part-time students receive \$1,250.

SPSFNWA's objective is to help single parents in Northwest Arkansas create futures for their families by providing direct financial assistance and supportive services for those who are pursuing higher education. The organization offers resources that inspire generational transformation, increase community awareness of single parents' educational barriers, and strengthen the region's workforce.
